# Installing Rhinoceros 6 on Windows

You can download Rhinoceros 6 from:

## Download and license request

1. In your preferred browser type the following URL:  
<https://www.rhino3d.com/download/rhino/6/latest/tudelft>

Enter your TU (student) email address and click **Next**. Your email address is usually your initials and lastname including dots, followed by @student.tudelft.nl or @tudelft.nl (like indicated below).

2. Check your email for a download link and license key.


*Didn't get the email? Please make sure:*

- You have used the correct email address.
- To check your junk mail folder.



## Installing Rhinoceros 6

1. Double-click the installation file that you have downloaded.

 rhino\_en-us\_6.5.18155.13161.exe

2. The next screen displays the Rhino installation menu. Agree with the terms and conditions and Click Install Now.

The application is installing.

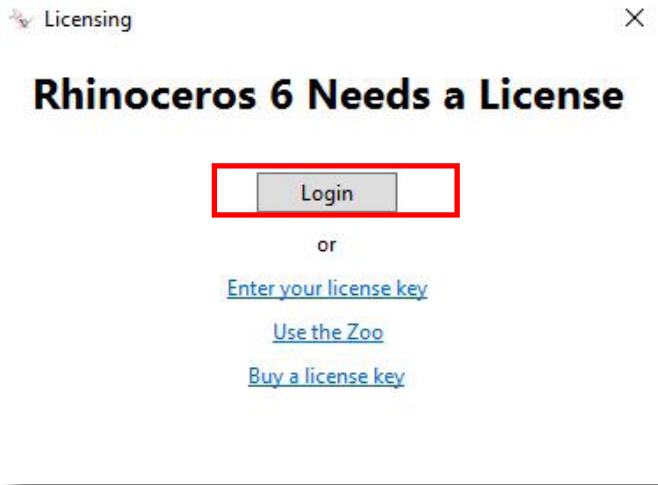


6. The next screen of the setup is displayed.  
Click Close.

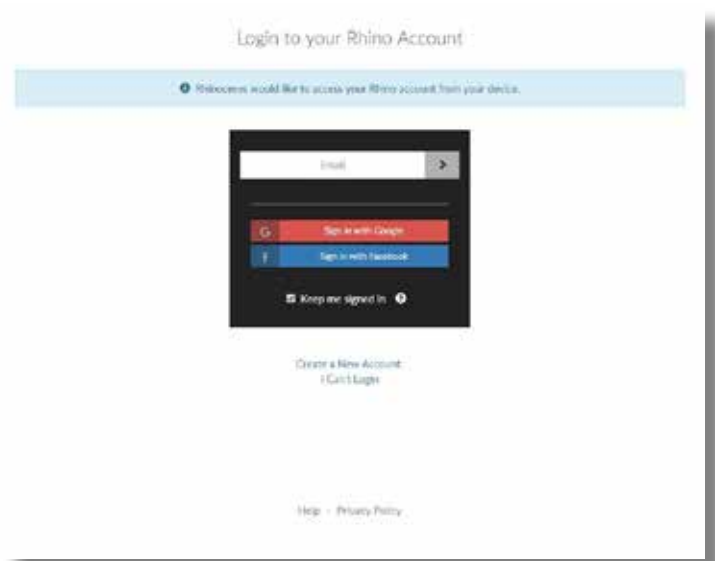


## Activating your Rhino License

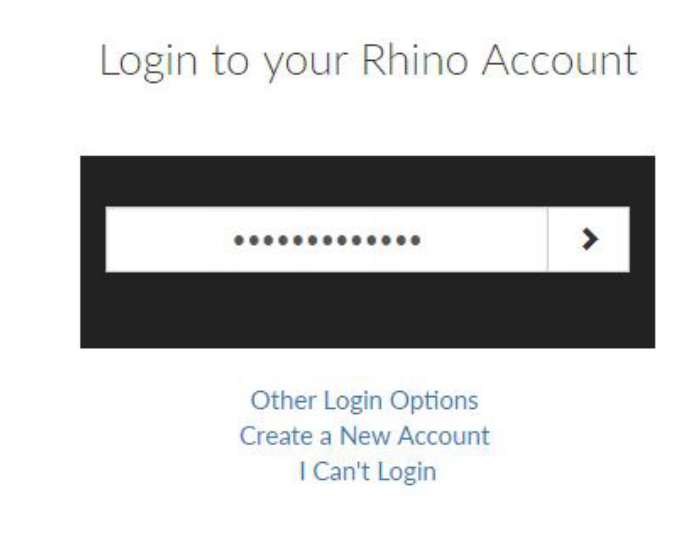
1. When you open Rhino, you will see the splash screen. Click on **Login**.



2. Enter the email address you used before to login and follow the steps.



3. Use your password to login.



4. Once you have logged in, you can hit **Close This Window** and start up your Rhino. The license is activated now.



**Optional:** Instead of clicking “Login” at the Splash Screen from step 1, you could also click **Enter your license code**. The only difference with the previous method is that you cannot use Rhino 6 on other devices with the same license key.
